Aktuell taucht ein weiterer schöner Beweis für die politische Schlagseite der „Enzyklopädie“ Wikipedia auf: Der Twitterer „Künstliche Intelligenz“ vergleicht einen Eintrag (Lemma) von Wikipedia mit dem entsprechenden in Elon Musks Grokipedia:

Active in public dissent, he has organized and joined protests against COVID-19 lockdowns and vaccine mandates, resulting in multiple arrests for breaching regulations and related charges, and ran as an independent in the 2021 London mayoral election to oppose perceived authoritarian policies.^{[5][6][7]}

He described SARS-CoV-2 as a "hoax", frequently campaigned against lockdowns and against COVID-19 vaccines, and described COVID-19 vaccines as dangerous. Corbyn was arrested on several occasions for taking part in protests against public health laws, and on suspicion of encouraging people to burn down the offices of
